<u>Class Participation</u> – All students are required to be engaged in the learning environment. Various participation grades will be given throughout each six weeks to be counted as daily grades. These grades will be used to monitor participation and to help keep students accountable in the classroom.

<u>Missed Assignments/Late Work</u> – Work that is received one class period late will be reduced **up to 15 points**, and work received two class periods late will be reduced **up to 30 points**. Work received beyond two days after the due date will receive no higher than a **50** and **will not be accepted beyond a week after the due date**. Students are responsible for collecting their own make-up work when absent.

<u>Grading</u> - All 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Pre-AP Language Arts classes will follow the grading policy below:

40% Major - (Tests/Projects)

30% Quizzes/Other (Vocabulary, Chapter Quizzes, other)

30% Minor (Daily work, Class work, Homework, Participation, etc.)

<u>Tutorials</u> – **Tutorials are available every morning at 8:15**. Students are encouraged to attend tutoring to receive extra instruction on struggling concepts or homework. All failed major tests must be retaken on the assigned day during morning tutorials. If a student fails to attend the make-up test, the failing grade will remain. On days that the teacher is on duty, students may attend tutorials in Mrs. Grosvenor's room, B405 or Mrs. Harris' room, B411.

Reading Material - Students will be given the opportunity for silent reading in the classroom. Therefore, each student needs to bring a book (not magazine) with them to class on the selected days determined by the teacher.
