<u>Students:</u>

If you cannot get the work done at home, please make time to come in before school and finish. My classroom is open every morning from 8:15-8:40 for you to use.
- Finally, and perhaps most importantly, BE RESPECTFUL. ALWAYS BE RESPECTFUL. Please, BE RESPECTFUL. This means with your words and actions. Whether it be towards me, other students, or the objects I allow you to use in my classroom, ALL should be treated with the utmost respect at all times.

<u> Parents:</u>

- Please push your student to do their assignments on their own and in a quiet and well-lighted environment. It is incredibly important that students begin to learn how to study and do it well at this age.
- Encourage your student to come and see me for tutorials, answers, or a quiet place to finish an assignment in the mornings before school. Please, do not let your students stay up incredibly late to get an assignment done. Encourage them to get their sleep and come see me in the morning.
- There are many ways (student's planner, edmodo alerts, panther newsletter) for you to see what upcoming assignments to look forward to and encourage your student to get started on. Get connected!
